ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02

ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON SANDY BAY ROAD TO 25 MPH

The Town Board of the Town of Two Rivers, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. <u>349.11</u>, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town.

A traffic and engineering investigation having been made on the following described highways, the maximum permissible speed at which vehicles *may* be operated on said highways, which speed is herewith established as reasonable and safe pursuant to Wis. Stat. 349.11 **shall** be as set forth herein subject to approval by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and upon the erection of standard signs.

Sandy Bay Road, Town of Two Rivers, Manitowoc County

Twenty-five miles per hour from the intersection with County Highway V in the Town of Two Rivers to the Town line of Town of Two Rivers and Town of Two Creeks..

This ordinance is effective on October 16, 2023. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. <u>60.80</u>, Wis. stats.
